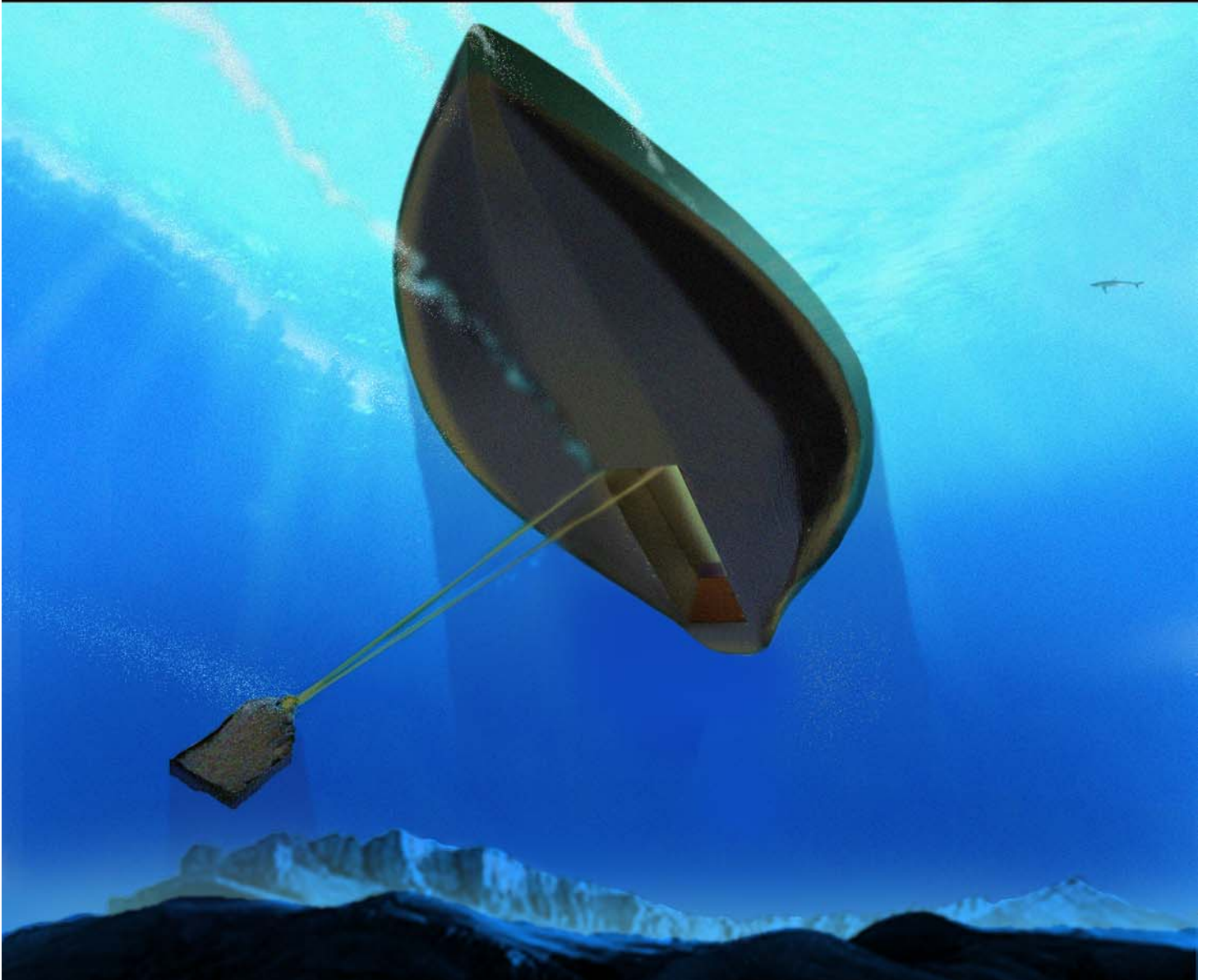


Noah's Ark

Noah's Ark coasts to a landing at Mesha

With one drouge anchor stone deployed, the big ship coasts directly to Mesha island / mountain, the landing technique is passive. The ship slowly drifts toward shore and when the anchor stone contacts the 30 foot limestone escarpment approximately 300 yards from the cliffs, the ship hoves to and remains anchored. South to north current aligns ship with scarp. Anchor line is hauled in by crew.
